WIA Global Network History

The Women in Aerospace (WIA) is a network devoted to expanding women's opportunities for leadership and increasing their visibility in the aerospace community. Our membership, women and men, shares an interest in a broad spectrum of aerospace issues, including human space flight, aviation, remote sensing, satellite communications, robotic space exploration, and the policy issues surrounding these fields.



1985 - WIA was founded in the USA - today it includes over 2000 members and over 80 corporate, non-profit, and academic partners



2009 - WIA Europe: the extension of this network to a global organization



2010 - WIA Canada was created



2011 - WIA Africa was created



2017 - WIA Mexico  and Japan  were created

Women In Aerospace Europe (WIA-Europe) is a non-profit association formed in 2009, on June 12th in Katwijk (NL), by:



- **Simonetta di Pippo**, Honorary President as Co-Founder of WIA-E and Director of UNOOSA,



- **Claudia Kessler**, Honorary Chair as Co-Founder of WIA-E and CEO of HE-Space.

- ✦ At start: ~30 members
- ✦ Now over 540 individual members
- ✦ 20 corporate members
- ✦ 12 Local Groups and others be created soon
